1. Commentary / Bible References

Blue Letter Bible

Excellent study platform with Strong's numbers, interlinear tools, cross-references, and multiple conservative commentaries (including Guzik and classic works). Grounded in historic conservative evangelical faith.

Features the NET Bible with extensive translator notes plus thousands of articles and resources from conservative scholars (many connected to Dallas Theological Seminary). Strong on careful, text-based exposition.

Constable's Expository Notes

Full-Bible notes by Dr. Thomas Constable (longtime Dallas Theological Seminary professor). Clear, conservative, dispensational evangelical exposition valued for teaching and study.

Pastor David Guzik's free, clear, verse-by-verse commentary covering the entire Bible. Pastoral, readable, and popular among conservative evangelicals for teaching and personal study. One of the most-used free modern commentaries online.

Founded by Henry Morris; emphasizes scientific research affirming biblical creation. Features technical papers, the Acts & Facts magazine, the RATE project on radiometric dating, column projects on stratigraphy, and educational resources. Strong research orientation.

Evangelical apologetics ministry dedicated to demonstrating the historical reliability of the Bible through original fieldwork (including licensed digs in Israel) and research. Publishes Bible and Spade and provides articles, dig reports, and analysis from a conservative perspective.
